35 (B) Have access to the distribution of fuel, food, water, supplies, equipment, and any
36 other materials necessary for maintaining or producing a broadcast or broadcasting
37 signal; and

38 (C) Not have vehicles, fuel, food, water, and any other materials seized or condemned
39 that are essential for maintaining or producing a broadcast or broadcasting signal.

SECTION 3.

41 The Idaho Emergency Management Agency may develop or adopt courses of
42 instruction for use in training personnel of first informer broadcasters on personal safety
43 and navigation in an area affected by an emergency. The requirements of any such
44 training shall be established pursuant to rules and regulations promulgated by the director
45 of emergency management. The costs of any such training shall be paid by the first
46 informer broadcasters participating in the training."

SECTION 2.

48 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
